I'm hoping that everyone has been enjoying the spring fishing so far, the Detroit and St. Clair Rivers have been producing great numbers of walleye this spring and surprisingly salmon & steelhead as well in the SCR. Lake St. Clair itself has been hit or miss for the walleye but the yellow perch action has been

nothing short of phenomenal which is very encouraging for another great year of fishing for them on LSC.

The lower water levels have been causing some problems for boaters this year, highlighting the problem at the Clinton's River Cutoff launch (CRCO). Water depths of barely over a foot were reported at the mouth coming off the lake and the MDNR has stated dredging will take place soon, as of this writing (5/1) a dredge was reportedly at the site the day prior, I will investigate to see if it happened. Further access problems on the road to Harley Ensign memorial boat launch only seem to frustrate us even more. One of the bridges on the road out to the point is being replaced and the road will experience delays through the coming months.

Derby season is under way once again, Lakeside Fishing Shop hosted us this past April, if you haven't been in there recently you should really stop in and check them out. Julie, longtime employee & now owner, has breathed new life into her shop and is always looking for ways to outfit fisherman with the gear they want and need.

For May's derby we will be at Sportmen's Direct on Sunday, May 25th from 3-4pm for the weigh in. June's derby we will be at Angler's Point on June 22nd and July will find up at Hook One in Marine City on the 20th of July.

We unfortunately had to cancel this year's Lake St. Clair Classic due to unforeseen circumstances. We are still going to hold our veterans fishing tournament, tentatively scheduled for November 22nd. We are also planning on our annual perch & pig with possibly additional dates and locations as well, follow our facebook page for more info.

MEMBERSHIP DUES FOR LSCWA

As your club membership person I'm writing this article to help members keep current with your dues. We are starting the 2025 year derbies with the April derby. You have to be a current member per derby rules to enter a fish. Before the start of a derby.

At the top of your monthly newsletter is an arrow pointing to your expiration of dues. The message of the arrow is a two prong notice of expiration for derbies, and membership. The derbies notice is a reminder to be paid before the derby in that month, per derby rules. The second part of the notice is for general club dues expiring at the end of the month.

An example of the expiration information under the arrow is month, year, type of membership such as 04,2024, S. This translates to April 2024 Single membership that will expire in that month.

You can renew a few different ways. One way is face to face meetings now that we have regular meetings. Second, the club web page, third, mailing a check to the post office.
