





The Little Things Add Up

I was talking to a fellow member at the last club weigh-in. He made the comment that the same people always are at the top of the divisions each month. He also observed that a lot of members were fishing in the same areas and using the same lures, but just didn't get the same results as the top anglers. I told him it's the little things that the top anglers do that add up to big catches.

The little things, like tying your harnesses with premium hooks and line, so you don't lose fish. Checking your harness often for nicks and replacing them when needed. Making sure the knots you tie are perfect. Getting the very best bait you can possibly get.

Some other little things you can do to catch more fish are:

- Gassing your boat when you get off the water, so you don't get gas on your hands in the morning going fishing.
- Putting sunscreen on at your house so you can wash your hands well before fishing.
- Using spray-on sunscreen on the boat, so you don't get any on your hands in the boat.
- Keeping no scent soap on the boat just in case you do.

One of the big reasons some of those top anglers keep out fishing everyone in the club is they just out work every one else. They put in a lot of hours and they never leave a lure in the water that is not catching fish. They also never let a weed foul a hook or leave a trash fish on the line too long.


