June 2025 President's Corner



August is already upon us and soon shall be another election at the August meeting. Right now all of the executive positions have nominations for them but we only have 4 nominations for 5 board of directors positions. Maybe this is your time to seek a board position? We are planning to have

new merchandise at the August meeting, t-shirts and zip up hoodies as well as hats and possibly order forms for Reaper jackets & Reaper hoodies.

Fall perch fishing should continue to be strong, 2024 was the best year most anglers can recall and all indications point to the trend to continue. The LSCWA is planning on 2 additional perch tournaments leading up to the annual perch 'n pig.

September 20th the perch tournaments start at Sportsmen's Direct and the following weekend on September 27 we will be holding a tournament at Lakeside Fishing Shop. These tournaments are both going to be single angler entry tournaments, \$25 per person with 100% payback.

The annual perch 'n pig tournament will be on October 4th at Anglers Point and the price is going to increase to \$140 per boat, with larger payouts for the biggest fish. Last year we had 38 entries with a \$1900 first place and a new overall record 25 fish basket took home the gold, will this year smash the record again? Entry forms are planned on being available in early August.

The Veterans Classic is planned for Nov 22nd this year. In its first year in 2024 we had 16 boats enter during a short entry period and we are hoping to add additional boats and sponsors this year. Please follow along on our Facebook page for more info.

Finally, the annual picnic will be held at Lake St. Clair Metropark on August 24th, wrapping up our summer derby season with the blind draw tournament being one of the most popular events of the year. We will also be drawing the Ron Sharp raffle prizes at this event as well as starting sales for the MUCC 400 Legend hunting rifle.

Vet Fishing




