

WCSX's "Cold as Ice" tournament sponsored by Dick Huvaere's Richmond Dodge, Ram and Jeep was a huge success! 245 registered anglers took to the ice in warm and windy conditions to compete for cash prizes for perch, pike and panfish. Ben Perez from WCSX once again contacted the LSCWA to officiate this fun winter tournament at Lake St. Clair Metropark, giving away cash, merchandise and prizes to many of the contestants who entered. 5 lucky people are even finalists in a contest for a trip to a Caribbean vacation, courtesy of WCSX!

We set our stage trailer up and once the official weighmaster Tim Muir took charge of the scale, shenanigans from the morning crew of WCSX's "Big Jim's House" started taking place! Jim O'Brien and Erin V. weighed in a basket of fish weighing slightly more than a pound, but were quickly disqualified by side judges Bob Barnes and Rich Benson for entering fish sticks! The real fisherman came next, roughly 80 people weighed fish in with \$250 prize for the 5 largest panfish prize going to Michael Columbo for his catch weighing 3.71 lbs. The \$500 largest pike award went to James Pype for his 29 3/4 northern pike that went 6.4 lbs. Finally, the grand prize of \$1,000 went to Robert Nielsen for his catch of 10 perch the weighed in at 5.54 lbs! Congratulations to all the winners and thanks to everyone who participated this year.



New Derby Rules

This article is to inform club members of changes to the existing and new derby activities. The new changes will be implemented and apply to derbies this year and future years. New this year, will be an Angler of the Year (AOY) award and a money Super Six Division.

First the new change to the general derby rules are, the new start time will be 4pm Friday, and the weigh-in will be from 3 pm to 4pm on Sunday.

In addition there will be an (AOY) Angler of the Year. The (AOY) will be based on entries from the general derbies April thru August. It is open to all members in good standing from all divisions, masters, open and youth. The points earned for (AOY) will be based on club derbies. The biggest walleye weighed will be given 5 points, other entries will be on a sliding scale down to 1 point for 5th place. The angler with the most points at the end of the year will be awarded with a plaque or trophy.

Super six will remain the same.

A more competitive Team Division that you can buy into is based on dollars. Teams can be up to three anglers. Each team must sign up at the start of the derby season and you can only be on one team. A \$50.00 entry fee per derby with a 50% pay back at each derby, and the other 50% will go toward the end of year team award. The points earned are on a sliding scale of 5 points for 1st down to 1 point for 5th place.

All LSCWA rules and boundaries for all derbies apply to the new derbies. The complete set of rules will be available on our website in the near future.

Michigan Out of Doors Walleye Chowder


My wife and I have searched for good chowder recipes and this one, in our opinion, is one of the best. Using walleye makes this recipe a lot more inexpensive than some of the clam/shrimp/crab recipes we've tried. Give this one a try after a day on the ice and I think you'll agree it's quite tasty. ~~~Jim Lease~~~

Ingredients

- 1/4 pound bacon, diced
- 4 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 1 cup onion, small dice
- 1/2 cup carrots, small dice
- 1/2 cup celery, small dice
- 1/2 cup all- purpose flour
- 2 cups clam juice or fish stock
- 2 cups heavy cream
- 1/2 pound or 2 medium sized potatoes, peeled and medium dice
- 1 cup corn fresh or frozen
- 1 pound Walleye, skin off, bone out, medium dice, raw or smoked
- Salt, to taste

Instructions

1. In a medium sized soup pot sweat bacon over medium heat until most of the fat has rendered out and bacon is cooked through
2. Strain most of the fat out and add butter
3. When butter is melted, add vegetables and cook until soft - 7-10 minutes
4. Slowly add flour and whisk vigorously for 1 minute
5. Slowly whisk in clam juice and bring mixture to a simmer
6. Slowly add cream and whisk vigorously until mixture comes to a boil
7. Add potatoes and immediately reduce to a bare simmer
8. Once potatoes are just cooked through (10-15 minutes) add corn and fish and bring to a boil
9. Let cook until fish is cooked through. This happens fast, 1-3 minutes depending on size of fish
10. Salt to your desired taste


2018 LSCWA Scholarship


