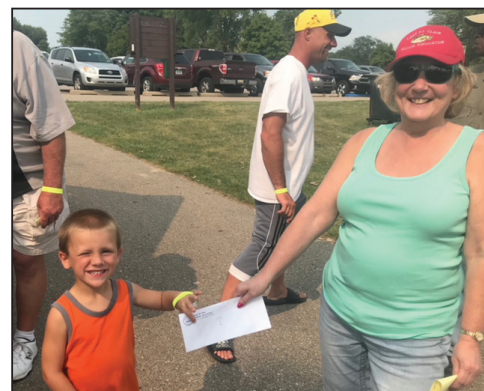

# BOATING SAFETY AND AMERICA'S BOATING COURSE

As fishers we tend to look at boats as a means to an end; that end being fishing. The water is a challenging environment with wind, waves, weather, and sometimes harsh air and water temperatures. There is Rules of the Water, regulations, and required equipment aboard based on the length of your boat which you must be familiar. America's Boating Course is a professionally prepared six week course, two hours per week, and presented by local squadrons. # CORNBREAD STUFFING RECIPE

I had quite a few people asking about the cornbread stuffing that I used to stuff the gator with for the picnic last month, so here it is, simple and sweet.

2-3boxes of prepared cornbread

-or-

2-3boxes of prepared cornbread stuffing

1 cup each of diced celery, carrots & onions

2 cups chicken stock

1-2 cups andouille sausage

1-2 cups of salad shrimp or crawfish-precooked

Old Bay seasoning

Add your vegetables, sausage and the chicken stock to a large pot, simmer them down for a bit, 1/2 hour or so. Add shrimp or crawfish, turn off heat and cover. Prepare stuffing mix or cornbread, if preparing cornbread crumble it up, stir into vegetables/crawfish mix. Season with Old Bay to taste, use this stuffing for nearly any occasion, it will be very wet. I prefer to place in large casserole and bake it for a bit if not using it to stuff the main course.

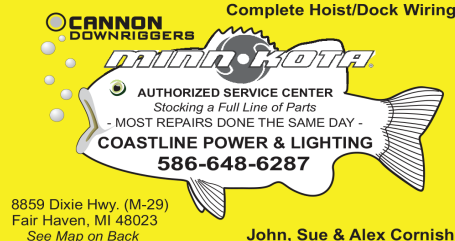
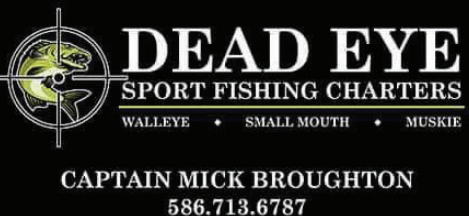
