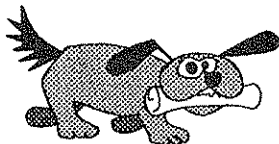

- Res. 10; One Buck Rule for the Upper Peninsula Failed.
- Res. 11; Mink Snaring, Failed.
- Res. 12; Open Water Beaver Snaring, Failed.
- Res. 13; Simplify Coyote & Fox Snaring, Failed.
- Res. 14; Wolf Population Problem; Failed.
- Res. 15; Deer Baiting Lost. (169Y/225N).
- Res. 16; One Buck per Calendar Year Season; Failed.
- Res. 17; Protection of MI State Parks & Rec Areas, Passed.
- Res. 18; Multiple Membership Requirements, Failed (194N/127Y). Will be restudied in near future.

- Res. 27; Hunting Big Game within High Fence Areas, Sent Back for Re-Write.
- Res. 28; Public Access, Passed Unanimously.
- Res. 29; Gold Prospecting (New Club), Passed Unanimously.
- Res. 30; Competitive Competition, (Unknown Results).
- Resolution #31; Calling for Regional Leadership on Global Warming; Passed.

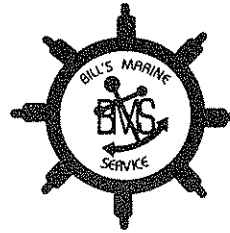

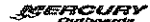

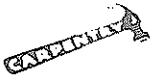
