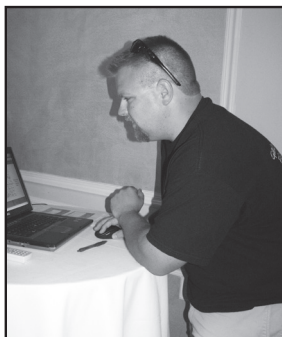

Party Boat

"Large saltwater fishing craft that carries a number of anglers, each of whom is charged a fee for the outing, which usually covers bait and the use of fishing tackle. Party boats are often crowded, and since the individual who catches the largest fish of the trip wins a pool of money made up of contributions by all on board, tempers can flare in close quarters when lines become tangled or a hooked fish is lost. For this reason, abiding by some simple shipboard etiquette is vital: a fellow angler should always be tapped lightly on the shoulder before being punched on the nose or chin; if bait has been handled, hands should be washed before

being placed around the neck of another fisherman; anyone who fails to respond to a slow ten-count is presumed to have given up his position at the rail; and no one should ever be thrown overboard while the fish are biting."

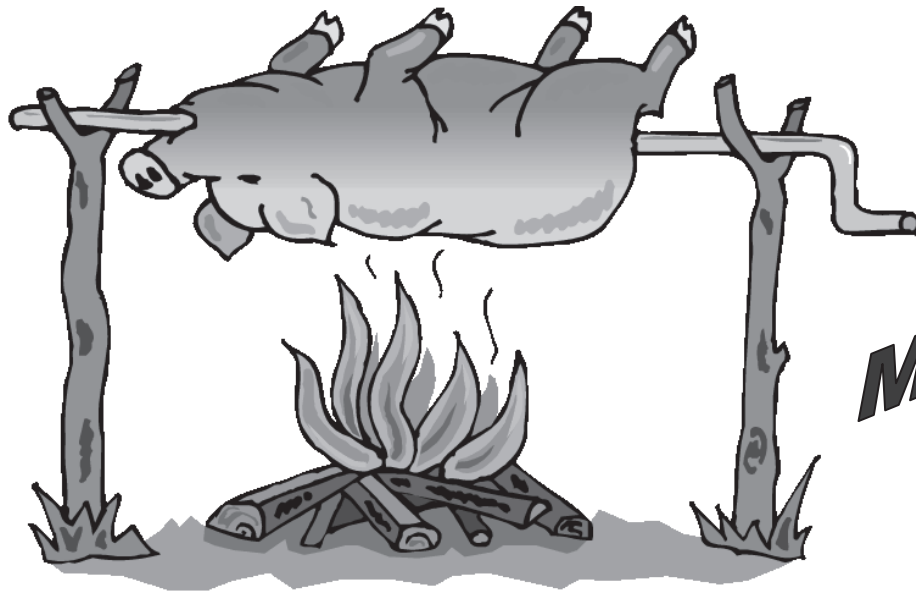

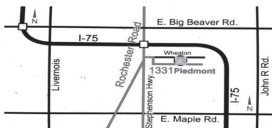

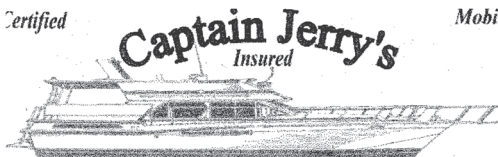
