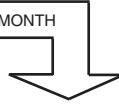

This Year's 4th Derby

The July derby was July 23rd-25th. The weather was the dominate force for this derby. Saturday was hot, sticky and calm followed by Sunday's wind and rain. Conditions were tough. I fished with president Rich and his dad Dick and son Richard. We did manage to catch fish and place 5th in the super six but were unable to find a couple of the bigger walleye that are swimming out there.

Turn out in the open division was much better than June. Good to see all the participation although it would be nice to see more entries in the youth division. First place in the masters went to Keith Krych with a nice 6.51lb. 2nd was Richard Koch with 5.72lbs and Dennis Strohbeck with 5.17lbs. In the open division we saw Ray Kalisz with a first place finish weighing in a 5.66lb walleye. Second place was Dan Krupa with 4.31lbs and won 2nd via a tiebreaker. His fish was 1/4" longer than the 3rd place Ed Kowalski's fish which was the identical 4.31lbs but only measured 23 5/8 inches. Only 2 youth entries this month. First was Isabelle VanArsdale with a nice 2.87lb fish. She deserved it after her Sunday morning, but that is a story for another day. 2nd was walleye master to be Joey Elliott with a 2.44 lb walleye. Super six winners were Ed Kowalski and Dan Krupa with and impressive 19.62 pounds. Congrats to all the winners and everyone who toughed it out in that weather to weigh in a fish. August is our last derby for the year and the weigh in will include the popular blind draw. Weigh a fish and you never know you could win a couple of bucks.

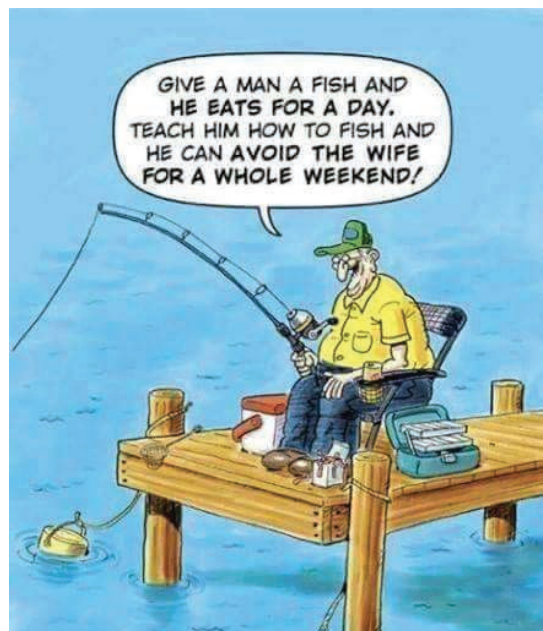

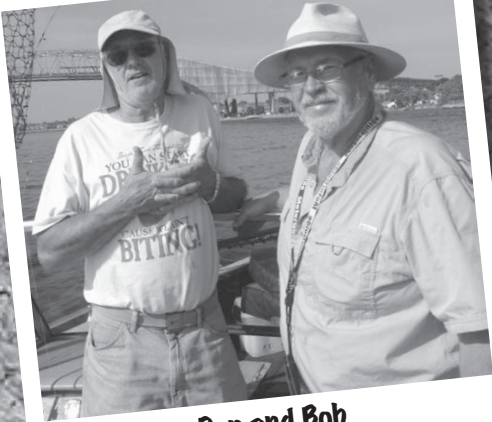

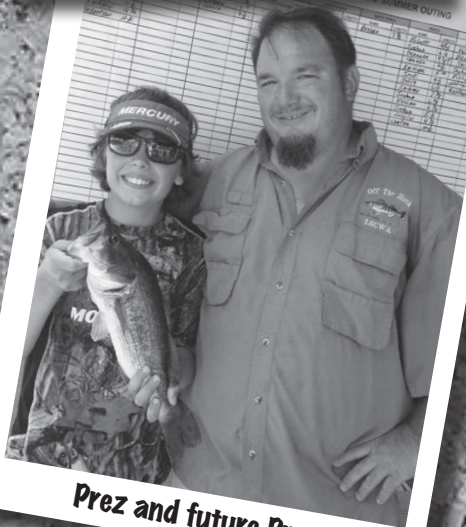
