LAKESIDE FISHING SHOP

What is Lakeside Fishing Shop? I have been trying to answer that question in a fairly concise article about our local "One Stop Fishing Shop" as the ad reads. Three months ago I visited Lakeside and spent time talking to Captain Dan and many of his employees. I visited the Lakeside web page and talked to more Lakeside employees and several of our club members who frequent this fishing shop on the corner of 10 mile and Jefferson. I want to do this story about Lakeside justice. I just cannot condense it down to a few paragraphs like most of my other articles.

Lakeside Fishing Shop is a Gold Mine. It is a place where smart fishermen and women go to find out where the many species of fish are biting and on what. What methods are producing more bass, walleye, Muskie or perch? Professional Tourney Anglers check in with Lakeside every year to better their odds against the competition. You can buy a specific lure or bait at Cabella's, Bass Pro, Dicks Sporting, or other places. However, you will not be given sound advice about color, size of lure, type of bait, etc...as you will get from the staff at Lakeside Fishing Shop.

Their building may not look very big on the outside, but I counted 16 rows of fishing lures and equipment 60 feet long x 6 feet high. That equates to almost 6,000 square feet of product to help us catch fish. Hey that is a lot of stuff. And also as LSCWA members we get coupons on their ½ page ad for 10 to 20 % off many products each month.

The first thing that struck me was that Lakeside F. S. was more like a happy family rather than a company where employees are stressed out. Each employee has several jobs to do and they willingly fill-in to help others when the Shop gets busy. They know most of the regular customers by first names. It is like the T-V show 'Cheers' without the Bar.

Originally founded by Larry Sawicki in 1968, Lakeside Fishing Shop had to close in 1984. It was reopened in March of 1985 by the present owners Veronica Pinto and Captain Dan Chimelak. The building was originally built in 1945. (I was 2 yrs old). It has 3,564 Sq. Ft. of Retail Space.

Captain Dans' only complaint is about when the City of St. Clair Shores widened Jefferson there, added a left turn lane and created the single car lane in front of his business over the objections of all the store owners nearby. Lakeside lost most of the previous parking spots they had.

If you look at a map of Lake St. Clair you will notice that Lakeside Fishing Shop at 10 Mile and Jefferson is about equal distance to the mouth of the Clinton River; the Firecracker at the end of the South Channel and also the mouth of the Detroit River. Hmmm! I guess that was planned.

LFS (Lakeside Fishing Shop) has been a close and important partner of our club for over 30 years. They have been an advertiser in our Walleye World from the beginning. LFS has also sponsored a LSCWA Derby weigh-in location for many years. This past year they hosted two of our five Derbies and helped us out Big Time. LFS donates prizes to many of our children's summer and winter fishing outings. Before we became a 501c3, LFS help out our club with contributions that kept us going and made our events worthwhile. We owe them a lot.

When we have a booth at the Novi Boat and Fishing Show in January; Lakeside Fishing Shop usually has the spaces on the other side of the curtain or nearby. When they get a fisherman inquiring about Walleye Info...they usually send them over to our booth. They are like family.

So if you want to catch more fish with less time spent on the water stop in to the Gold Mine located on Jefferson at the corner of Ten Mile. Say Hi! To Captain Dan, Julie Beltowski, Aaron Mausolf, Mary McGerty, Erin Paul, Dan Beste, Don Murray, or Jim Bates. You will pick up a few good fishing tips.










Winner of the 2011 O.B. Motor (Story in December Issue)


